Substitutability CORRECT ANSWERS An ad might offer the user a product or service that is not exactly what the user queried for. For example, for the user query [lg fridge freezer], an ad of [samsung fridge freezer] might show up. When the ad presents a product or service that has some difference to the queried one, you will have to carefully assess how well the advertised product or service is connected to the user's original query.

Reasonable Substitute CORRECT ANSWERS When the user indicates that they want a certain product / service from a certain brand or provider, and the ad appears to offer the same or a very similar product / service from a different brand, provider or competitor, you should generally consider this as a reasonable substitute / alternative to the queried product / service.
