

Lease compensation for this program became available in 2014 following successful litigation establishing the obligation of the Federal Government to fund – however there was little utilization of this program until 2019, when additional tribes sought compensation.

The BIA Central Office Division of Real Estate Services is located in Albuquerque, New Mexico and develops policy, processes, and provides nation-wide training and technical assistance to Tribal governments and BIA field offices.

Indian Affairs aims to complete leases within 90 days, but the process can take longer if additional technical assistance is necessary or if Tribes need more time to pull together the necessary information or get Tribal resolutions approving the lease.
