According to the Merriam-Webster online dictionary, the noun (which means "sustantivo" in Spanish) is a word that refers to a thing, a person, an animal, a place, a quality, an idea, or an action. Example: Maria, cow, Boston, active, justice, teaching.

In Spanish, the nouns have **gender** (masculine or feminine) and **number** (singular or plural) and as there is no clear rule that helps us to identify the gender of a word, then we are guided by the following:

Words ending in 'O' are usually masculine and words ending in 'a' are feminine.
Example: carro (m), libro (m), casa (f), familia (f).

There are exceptions and they are the words that end in 'ma' but are masculine. Example: problema (problem), lema (motto), dilemma (dilemma), poema (poem).

- The words ending in 'ión', 'dad' and 'tad' are feminine. Example: operación (operation), humanidad (humanity), amistad (friendship).
- When we mention people, we form the feminine in the following way from the masculine word, examples: profesor = profesora; señor = señora; niño = niña.
- Nouns that end in 'e' can be changed to an 'a' or add 'sa', for example: jefe = jefa (chief) or duque = duquesa (duke duchess).
- If the masculine form ends in a consonant, the feminine is usually formed by adding an 'a': jugador = jugador (player); escritor = escritor (writer); conversador = conversador (conversationalist).
