Crone goddesses epitomize wisdom, courage, power, and sometimes death and destruction.

- Maiden goddesses: Artemis, Diana, Bast, Athena, Bhairavi
- Mother goddesses: Brigid, Isis, Demeter, Antares, Inanna, Ishtar, Tara, Sekhmet, Yemaya, Oshtai
- Crone goddesses: Hecate, Ceridwen, Kali, Sophia

Because the moon holds such significance for witches, you may choose to organize your book of shadows around your esbat rituals.
