4. CREATIVE WRITING PROMPTS

- RHYMING POEMS: STUDENTS CAN BE TASKED WITH WRITING SHORT POEMS OR COUPLETS THAT INCORPORATE THREE-LETTER RHYMING WORDS.

- CREATE A RHYMING WALL: DISPLAY A "RHYMING WALL" IN THE CLASSROOM WHERE STUDENTS CAN CONTRIBUTE NEW RHYMING WORDS THEY DISCOVER.
