Because polyuria is an adverse effect of lithium in 50% to 70% of clients treated, HYPOnatremia is a significant risk. The nurse should reinforce teaching with the client about eating consistent amounts of sodium and drinking 2 to 3 L of fluid daily to help prevent lithium toxicity.
