UNDERSTANDING SENTENCE TYPES

COMPOUND SENTENCES

A COMPOUND SENTENCE CONTAINS AT LEAST TWO INDEPENDENT CLAUSES JOINED BY A COORDINATING CONJUNCTION (FOR, AND, NOR, BUT, OR, YET, SO). THESE SENTENCES CAN CONVEY MORE INFORMATION THAN SIMPLE SENTENCES.

- EXAMPLE: | WANTED TO GO FOR A WALK, BUT IT STARTED TO RAIN.
- EXAMPLE: HE LIKES COFFEE, AND SHE PREFERS TEA.

COMPOUND SENTENCES ALLOW WRITERS TO CONNECT RELATED IDEAS, ENHANCING THE FLOW OF THEIR WRITING.

COMPLEX SENTENCES

A COMPLEX SENTENCE CONSISTS OF ONE INDEPENDENT CLAUSE AND AT LEAST ONE DEPENDENT CLAUSE. THE DEPENDENT CLAUSE CANNOT STAND ALONE AND IS OFTEN INTRODUCED BY SUBORDINATING CONJUNCTIONS (BECAUSE, SINCE, WHEN, ALTHOUGH, ETC.).

- Example: Although it was raining, we decided to go for a hike.
- EXAMPLE: SHE WILL FINISH HER HOMEWORK BEFORE DINNER.

COMPLEX SENTENCES ADD DEPTH TO WRITING BY PROVIDING ADDITIONAL INFORMATION AND CONTEXT.

IMPORTANCE OF WORKSHEETS

• EXAMPLE: SHE RUNS. SHE RUNS EVERY MORNING BECAUSE SHE WANTS TO STAY HEALTHY.

4. CREATIVE WRITING EXERCISE

ENCOURAGE STUDENTS TO WRITE A SHORT PARAGRAPH THAT INCLUDES AT LEAST ONE EXAMPLE OF EACH SENTENCE TYPE. THIS NOT ONLY REINFORCES THEIR UNDERSTANDING BUT ALSO PROMOTES CREATIVITY.
