- SINCE
- UNLESS
- WHILE
- 3. CORRELATIVE CONJUNCTIONS:
- These conjunctions are used in pairs to connect equivalent elements in a sentence. Examples include:
- EITHER...OR
- NEITHER...NOR
- NOT ONLY...BUT ALSO

WORKSHEET ACTIVITIES FOR CONJUNCTIONS
