|  <p><b>Super</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-Card art is foiled, name is normal</li><li>-Third most common printing; guaranteed Super or higher in <i>Breakers of Shadow</i> onward</li><li>-Also found in various other products as promos, reprints, and/or "all foil" sets like <i>Hidden Arsenal</i> or <i>The Secret Forces</i></li><li>-Abbreviation: SR</li></ul>                     |  <p><b>Ultra</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-Card art is foiled, name is gold</li><li>-Fourth most common printing</li><li>-Also found in various other products as promos or reprints</li><li>-Abbreviation: UR</li></ul>  |
|  <p><b>Secret</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-Card art has diagonal patterned foil, name is holographic silver</li><li>-Third/Most* rarest card in a main set</li><li>-Also found in various reprint products such as collector's tins or sets like <i>Hidden Arsenal</i></li><li>-Abbreviation: ScR</li><li>*Third rarest = Most sets before BOSH, post-BOSH = rarest card a set</li></ul> |  <p><b>Ultimate</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-Card art has embossed foil, as well as the borders, attribute, and level /rank stars on monsters, name is gold (like UR)</li><li>-Fourth rarest card in a main set (pre-BOSH) / Only found in tournament packs (post-BOSH)</li><li>-Only reprints of other cards of other rarities (no cards are exclusively Ultimate)</li><li>-Abbreviation: UIR</li></ul>  |
|  <p><b>Ghost</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-Card art has a special foil that depending on the angle changes colours, initially looks silver and white (hence the name "Ghost"), name is holographic (similar to ScR)</li><li>-Rarest card in a main set pre-BOSH</li><li>-Currently on "hiatus" from main sets post-BOSH</li><li>-Abbreviation: GR</li></ul>                              |   |
